**Martin Luther King, Jr. Day Excursion
to Morristown, New Jersey**

Join us on Monday, January 18, as we take a trip over the rivers and through some woods to beautiful and historic Morristown, New Jersey. We will meet at 9:00 am in the lobby of the Brooklyn Marriott (333 Adams St.), for a planned departure around 9:15.

Our first stop is the historic **St. Peter's Episcopal Church**, with its 1930 E.M. Skinner organ, Opus #836. Music Director Brian Harlow will meet us to tell us about this fully-restored masterpiece of organ building, and will demonstrate the instrument. There will be time for those who wish to try out the instrument to do so, as well.



Lunch will be Dutch-treat, at one of the many lovely restaurants in the center of Morristown.



Following lunch, we will go for a visit to **Morristown National Historic Park**. This fascinating park preserves George Washington's Headquarters and the area in which the Continental Army camped in the winters of 1777 and 1779. We are currently making plans to have one of the park rangers speak to our group and answer any questions.

Finally, we visit the **Church of the Redeemer**, which houses a 1918 J.W. Steere & Son organ (sister instrument to the Brooklyn Baptist Temple). Ed Alstrom, Music Director, will meet us to discuss the instrument and its history. Again, there will be opportunity for members to play the instrument, if desired.



We plan to return to the Brooklyn Marriott between 5 and 5:30 pm.
